

BON List of Charges



Below is a list of charges used in the documentary, Betrayal of a Nation.

Fraud

A criminal act that takes place when someone gains something of value from a victim by intentionally misrepresenting the matter

Robbery

A crime that involves stealing something from another person, either by force, fear, or intimidation

Kidnapping

The taking of a person from one place to another against his or her will, or the confining of a person to a controlled space

Human Trafficking

Recruitment, harboring or transporting people into a situation of exploitation through the use of violence, deception or coercion to a controlled space

Rape

Non-consensual sexual intercourse that is committed by physical force, threat of injury, or other duress

Sexual Assault

Any crime in which the offender subjects the victim to sexual touching that is unwanted and offensive

Child Abuse

Any type of cruelty inflicted upon a child, including physical or emotional harm, endangerment, abandonment, neglect or sexual abuse

Battery

Committed when one person: 1) tries to or does physically strike another, or 2) acts in a threatening manner to put another in fear of immediate harm

Aggravated Assault

Causing severe injury to another

Assault with a Deadly Weapon

Use of a deadly weapon during an assault

Cruel and Unusual Punishment

Measures a particular punishment against society's prohibition against inhuman treatment.

Voluntary Manslaughter

A killing that results from: "The heat of passion" or "sudden fit of rage"

Murder in the First Degree

- 1) A charge that may be filed against a defendant who is involved in a dangerous crime where a death results from the crime
- 2) Murder that is intentional, willful and premeditated with malice aforethought

Omission; Failure to Act

When a party has an affirmative duty to perform a certain act but does not do so and results in injury, harm, or death

Lynching

An act of violence inflicted by a mob that results in the death of the victim or physical injury to the victim

Inciting a Riot

When a person simultaneously with ten or more other persons, engages in causes or creates a grave risk of causing public alarm, and in the course of and as a result of such conduct, a person other than one of the participants suffers physical injury or substantial property damage occurs

Arson

The willful and malicious burning or charring of property

Criminal Negligence

An indifference or disregard for human life or for the safety of other individuals

Stalking

Unwanted surveillance by an individual or group towards another person or group

Wiretapping

To intentionally or purposefully intercept, disclose, or use the contents of any wire, oral, or electronic communication through the use of a "device"

Harassment

Unwanted, unwelcomed and uninvited behavior that demeans, threatens or offends the victim and results in a hostile environment for the victim

Restricting the movement of an individual without any legal justification
